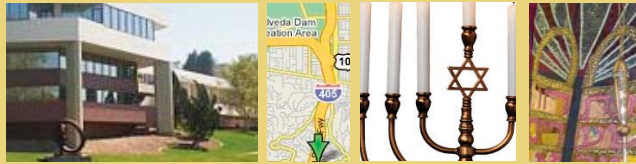




it's just up the street...

Now that LBT has officially had its "Groundbreaking," we will be holding Shabbat services at the **American Jewish University**,

located at 15600 Mulholland Drive, Bel Air - beginning in November.

American Jewish University

From West Los Angeles:
 Take I-405 N toward Sacramento
 Take the SKIRBALL CTR DR exit
 Turn LEFT onto SKIRBALL CTR DR
 Stay STRAIGHT to go onto MULHOLLAND DR
 Turn RIGHT onto CASIANO (Parking is on your right.)

From the San Fernando Valley:
 Take I-405 S toward Santa Monica
 Take the SKIRBALL CTR DR exit
 Turn LEFT onto SKIRBALL CTR DR
 Stay STRAIGHT to go onto MULHOLLAND DR
 Turn RIGHT onto CASIANO (Parking is on your right.)

During this time of transition at LBT, our Shabbat services, Bar/Bat Mitzvah celebrations, and various other events will take place in **three** locations at the AJU - the **Chapel**, **Gindi Auditorium** (both are in the same building and use the same parking lot - **parking lot 3**), plus the **Colen Conference Center** (slightly farther up Casiano using **parking lot 5**).

DIRECTIONS VIA SEPULVEDA...The directions above show how to get to the AJU via the area's freeways from all directions. For members used to going Sepulveda Boulevard, simply continue north (past the temple) until you reach Skirball Center Drive and take a right turn. Continue straight onto Mulholland Drive and then turn right onto Casiano Road.

Please note that the Early Childhood Center, Religious and Hebrew Schools will continue to meet in their usual classrooms during this stage of renovations. Other LBT classes and meetings will take place in either the Religious School buildings or the Early Childhood Center, so please refer regularly to the weekly congregational email and the monthly Bulletin for details during the coming year.
